Luke 22:7	then came the Day of Unleavened Bread, when the Passover must be killed
John 13:1	now before the Feast of the Passover
	* Prepared the Passover
Matt. 26:18	the Teacher said "My time is at hand, I will keep the Passover at your house with My disciples"
19	the disciples did as Christ had directed them they prepared the Passover
Mark 14:14	the Teacher said "where is the guest room in which I may eat the Passover with My disciples?"
16	the disciples found the room just as He had said
they prepared Luke 22:8	
Luke ZZ:8	Son of God sent Peter & James, saying "go and prepare us the Passover that we may eat"

Matt. 27:15	now at the feast the governor wanted to release

Mark 15:6	now at the feast Pilate released unto them one prisoner whomever they desired
Luke 23:17	of necessity he must release one person unto them at the feast
