1 Cor. 5:7                indeed, Christ our Passover, was sacrificed for us  
Matt. 27:45              6th hour to 9th hour -- noon to 3:00 p.m.  
                            46                      9th hour -- 3:00 p.m.

                            where the word "passover" is used

  - \* "Pascha" -- (Strong's #3957) -- noun  
                            Passover  
                            Passover week  
                            Passover meal  
                            Passover lamb  
Translated "passover" -- 28 times  
Translated "Easter" -- 1 time

- \* 2 Other Verses Not in the Gospels

Acts 12:4                King James version -- intending after "Easter"  
                            to bring forth to the people  
Heb. 11:28              by faith, Moses kept the Passover and the sprinkling  
of blood -- lest he who destroyed the firstborn should touch them

- \* Passover in Jerusalem

Luke 2:41                His parents went to Jerusalem every year at the  
                            Feast of the Passover  
                            42                      and when He was 12 years old, they went up to  
    Jerusalem according to the custom of the  
    feast

John 2:13                    now the Passover of the Jews was at hand, and  
                              Jesus went up to Jerusalem  
 John 2:23                    now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover,  
                              during the feast day, many believed in His  
                              name when they saw the signs which He did  
 John 6:4                    now the Passover, a feast of the Jews, was near  
 John 11:55                  and the Passover of the Jews was near, and many from  
 the country up to Jerusalem -- before the Passover to purify themselves

\*        2 days before

Matt. 26:1-2                when Jesus had finished all these sayings, He  
                              said unto His disciples -- "you know that  
                              after two days is the Passover, and the Son  
                              of Man will be delivered up to be crucified"  
 Mark 14:1                  after 2 days, it was the Passover and the Feast  
                              of Unleavened Bread . . .  
 Luke 22:1                  now the Feast of Unleavened bread drew near,  
                              which is called Passover

\*        Leaders plotted to kill Him

Matt. 26:3-4                chief priests, scribes and elders of the people  
                              assembled at the palace of the high priest  
                              (Caiaphas), and plotted to take Jesus by  
                              trickery and kill Him  
                              5        they concluded -- "not during the feast, lest there  
                              be an uproar among the people"  
 Mark 14:1-2                . . . the chief priests and the scribes sought  
                              how they might take Him by trickery and put  
                              Him to death -- they concluded, "not during  
                              the feast, lest there be an uproar of the  
                              people"  
 Luke 22:2                  chief priests and scribes sought how they might  
                              kill Him -- for they feared the people

\*        Went to Bethany

Matt. 26:6-13              Bethany  
                              6        Bethany -- in the house of Simon the leper  
                              7        woman -- alabaster flask -- precious ointment --  
                              poured it on His head  
                              8-9       disciples -- indignation  
                              10-12     Jesus defended her  
                              13       tell what this woman has done -- memorial  
 Mark 14:3-9                Bethany  
                              3        Bethany -- in the house of Simon the leper --  
                              woman -- alabaster flask -- poured it on  
                              His head  
                              4-5       some -- indignation  
                              6-8       Jesus defended her  
                              9        tell what this woman has done -- memorial  
 Luke 22                    this Bethany account -- not mentioned in Luke  
 John 12:1-8                Bethany

1           6 days before the Passover, Jesus came Bethany  
 2           they made Him a supper  
 3           Mary took a pound of spikenard (very costly) --  
             anointed His feet and wiped His feet with  
             her hair -- the house was filled with the  
             fragrance of oil  
 4-6         Judas Iscariot complained  
 7-8         Jesus defended her -- "let her alone"

\*         Feast of Unleavened Bread

Matt. 26:17         now on the first day of the Feast of Unleavened  
                     Bread, the disciples came to Jesus saying  
                     -- "where do You want us to prepare for You  
                     to eat the Passover?"

Mark 14:12         on the first day of Unleavened Bread, when they killed  
                     the Passover lamb, His disciples said --  
                     "where do You want us to go and prepare,  
                     that You may eat the Passover?"

Luke 22:7           then came the Day of Unleavened Bread, when the  
                     Passover must be killed

John 13:1           now before the Feast of the Passover

\*         Prepared the Passover

Matt. 26:18         the Teacher said -- "My time is at hand, I will  
                     keep the Passover at your house with My  
                     disciples"

            19         the disciples did as Christ had directed them  
                     -- they prepared the Passover

Mark 14:14         the Teacher said -- "where is the guest room in which  
                     I may eat the Passover with My disciples?"

            16         the disciples found the room just as He had said --  
 they prepared the Passover

Luke 22:8           Son of God sent Peter & James, saying -- "go and  
                     prepare us the Passover that we may eat"

            9         they asked Christ -- "where do you want us to  
                     prepare?"

            11         the Teacher said -- "where is the guest room where  
                     I may eat the Passover with My disciples?"

            13         the disciples went and found it just as He had  
                     said -- and they prepared the Passover

            14         when the hour came, He sat down with the 12  
 apostles

            15         He said -- "with desire I have desired to eat  
                     this Passover with you before I suffer"

            16         "for I say unto you, I will not any more eat  
                     thereof, until it be fulfilled in the  
                     Kingdom of God"

\*         Symbols

John 13:2-17         supper being ended  
 Matt. 26:26-30       bread and wine

Mark 14:22-26            bread and wine  
Luke 22:17-22           bread and wine

\*       Not defiled for the Passover

John 18:28            Jesus came from Caiaphas to the Praetorium -- they  
                         did not go into the Praetorium lest they  
                         should be defiled, but that they might eat  
                         the Passover

\*       Custom to release someone at Passover

John 18:39            you have a custom that I should release unto you at  
                         the Passover -- should I release unto the  
                         King of the Jews?

Matt. 27:15            now at the feast -- the governor wanted to release  
a prisoner -- whom the people wanted

Mark 15:6             now at the feast -- Pilate released unto them  
                         one prisoner -- whomever they desired

Luke 23:17            of necessity -- he must release one person unto them  
                         at the feast

John 19:12            Pilate sought to release Him -- but the Jews complained  
     13               Pilate brought Jesus to the judgment seat  
     14               it was the preparation of the Passover -- 6th hour  
                         (noon)

\*Preparation Day of the Passover -- 6th hour (noon)

John 19:14            now it was the Preparation Day of the Passover and  
                         about the 6th hour (noon) -- Pilate said,  
                         "behold your King"
