Titus 3:4-7 saved by grace
 4-5 kindness and love of God our Savior toward man
 appeared -- not by works of righteousness
 (which we have done) -- but according to
 His mercy He saved us
 through the washing of regeneration
 through the renewing of the Holy Spirit
 6 Holy Spirit poured out on us abundantly --
through Jesus Christ our Savior
 7 justified by His grace -- we should become heirs
according to hope of eternal life
 8 be committed -- to maintain good works

* Exodus 20:1-2

Exod. 20:1-2 I am the Lord your God -- who brought you out
 of the land of Egypt (house of bondage)
 3-17 the 10 Commandments
 3 no other gods before God
 4-6 not bow down to serve -- graven images
 7 not take the name of God in vain
 8-11 remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy
 12 honor father and mother
 13 not murder
 14 not adultery
 15 not steal
 16 not false witness
 17 not covet

* Son of God -- want us to only keep 5 of 10?

Matt. 19:16-19 keep the commandments -- which ones?
 not murder -- 6
 not adultery -- 7
 not steal -- 8
 not false witness -- 9
 honor parents -- 5
 "love your neighbor as yourself"
 Just those 5?

 "love your neighbor as yourself"

 not covet -- 10
 Just those 5?
 Just Commandments 6-10?
 Mark 12:28-34 2 great commandments
 29-31 Love the Lord your God
 your heart
 your soul
 your mind
 your strength
 Love your neighbor as yourself
 32-33 scribe said -- greater than burnt offerings and
 sacrifices
 34 Son of God said -- "You are not far from the Kingdom
 of God"
 *Why did Paul (in Galatia) focus upon the last 6
 Commandments?
 Gal. 5:13 called to liberty -- not an opportunity to sin
 -- opportunity to serve
 14 all the law is fulfilled in one word -- "You shall
 love your neighbor as yourself"
 15 not bite and devour each other -- beware lest
 you be consumed by one another
 1 Thes. 1:9-10 Paul served the living and true God
 *4 examples -- when the Son of God warned His disciples
 to avoid consuming each other
 Matthew 7:1-5 not condemn others -- beam in own eye
 Luke 18:9-14 parable of Pharisee and tax-collector
 John 8:1-11 the woman caught in adultery
 John 13:34 a new commandment I give to you -- that you love one
 another -- as I have loved you
 35 by this all will know that you are My disciples --
 if you have love for one another
 * John remembered the instruction
 1 John 4:20-21 love God -- must love his brother also
