9	brothers sold Joseph into Egypt
Gen. 37:28	brothers sold Joseph to Midianites to Egypt

Acts 7:10	God was with Joseph -- delivered him
Gen. 41:37-45	God gave Joseph favor with Pharaoh
Gen. 42:6	Joseph was governor over the land

Acts 7:11 a large famine came
Gen. 41:56 the famine was over the face of the earth

Acts 7:12	Jacob sent his sons to Egypt to buy corn
Gen. 42:1-2	Jacob sent his sons to Egypt to buy corn

Acts 7:13	Joseph revealed himself to his brothers and
Joseph's family	became known to Pharaoh
Gen. 45:1-4	Joseph revealed himself to his brothers
16	Joseph's family became known to Pharaoh

Acts 7:14	Joseph sent for his father & relatives (75)
Gen. 45:17-20	Joseph sent for his father
Gen. 46:2-4	in a vision, God told Jacob to go to Egypt
29	Joseph greeted his father -- hugged his neck
30-34	Joseph prepared for his family to meet Pharaoh
	-- Joseph told them -- land of Goshen
Gen. 47:1-10	Joseph brought his family to Pharaoh
11	Joseph gave his family possession in best land of Egypt
(Rameses)	-- Pharaoh commanded

Acts 7:15-16	Jacob lived in Egypt -- when Jacob died, he was buried in Shechem
Gen. 47:27-31	Jacob did not want to be buried in Egypt
Gen. 50:13-14	after Jacob was buried, they returned to Egypt
15-21	after Jacob died, the brothers were afraid that Joseph would seek revenge against them
24	Joseph told his brothers that God would bring them to the land that He promised to Abraham,

Isaac and Jacob

* The Israelites multiplied in Egypt

Acts 7:17 the Israelites grew in Egypt
18 another king arose, who did not know Joseph
19 this Pharaoh dealt treacherously with them Exod.
1:8 a new Pharaoh -- who did not know Joseph
9-14 taskmasters -- hard bondage
15-22 Pharaoh -- throw male children into the river

* Moses was born

Acts 7:20 Moses was born -- father's house for 3 months
21 Pharaoh's daughter -- raised him as her own son
Exod. 2:1-10 Moses is spared from murder

Acts 7:22 Moses -- mighty in words and deeds
23 40 years old -- visited his brethren
24 he defended a brother -- killed an Egyptian
Exod. 2:11-12 Moses murdered an Egyptian

* Acts 7:25 -- not chronological event of Exodus

Acts 7:26-28 2 brothers were fighting -- Moses intervened --
"Who made you a ruler and a judge over us?"
-- "Do you want to kill me, as you did the
Egyptian yesterday?"
Exod. 2:13-14 Moses and the 2 men fighting

Acts 7:29 Moses fled to the land of Midian
Exod. 2:14-15 news spread -- Pharaoh sought to slay Moses --
Moses fled to land of Midian
16-22 Moses met a priest of Midian -- Moses dwelt there
& married one of his daughters
23 Pharaoh died
23 children of Israel cried out -- their bondage
24 God heard them -- remembered the covenant --
Gen. 12:2-3...Gen. 26:2-5...Gen. 28:13-15
25 God acknowledged them

Acts 7:30 angel appeared -- flame of fire in a bush
Exod. 3:1-2 God appeared upon Moses -- flame of fire

Acts 7:31-32 God of Abraham, God of Isaac, God of Jacob
Exod. 3:6 God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob

Acts 7:33 remove your sandals
Exod. 3:5 remove your sandals

Acts 7:34 I have seen the oppression of My people in Egypt
-- I will send you
Exod. 3:7-10 oppression -- heard their cry -- will deliver
them -- I will send you

* Back to Acts 7:25

*For Moses thought that his brethren would understand that God would deliver them by the hand of Moses, but they did not understand -- notice that Moses did not always understand

Acts 7:25 Moses thought his brethren would understand that God was using him to deliver them -- they didn't understand
Exod. 3:11 initially -- Moses had his own reservations -- "who am I that I should go to Pharaoh?"
 12-15 God reassured Moses
 12 "I will certainly be with you" -- "when you have brought the people out of Egypt, you shall serve God on this mountain"
 13 when I say the God of your fathers has sent me, what name shall I say?
 14 I AM WHO I Am
 15 God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob
Exod. 4:1 again -- Moses expressed reservations
 2-9 God gave Moses 3 miracles to show Pharaoh
 2-5 #1 -- rod -- into a serpent -- back to a rod
 6-7 #2 -- hand -- leprous hand -- normal hand
 8-9 #3 -- water into blood
 10 again -- Moses expressed reservations
 11-12 again -- God reassured Moses
 13 Moses asked for someone else to be sent
 14-16 God was angry -- yet, God agreed to send Aaron
 17 God reminded him to take his rod
Exod. 5:20-21 the Israelites complained against Moses

Acts 7:35-36 Stephen confirmed -- this Moses is the one that God sent -- Egypt, Red Sea & wilderness

* THE OUTCOME WAS KNOWN

Exod. 3:16-22 God told Moses to tell the elders about outcome
 19 God foretold about Pharaoh's reactions -- I am sure king of Egypt will not let you go
 20 I will strike Egypt with wonders -- after that, he will let you go
 21-22 you will plunder the Egyptians
Exod. 4:18-20 Moses headed for Egypt
 21 God repeated to Moses about Pharaoh's reactions
 * Do all those wonders before Pharaoh
 * But I will harden his heart that he will not let the people go
 22-23 God foretold about the 10th plague

* Say: "Israel is My son, My firstborn"
* Say: "Let My son go, that he may serve Me"

* Say: "If you refuse to let him go, indeed I will kill your son, your firstborn"

* "Let My People Go"

Exod. 5:1 that they may hold a feast to Me in wilderness
Exod. 7:16 before 1st plague -- that they may serve Me in the wilderness
Exod. 8:1 before 2nd plague -- that they may serve Me
Exod. 8:20 before 4th plague -- that they may serve Me
Exod. 9:1 before 5th plague -- that they may serve Me
Exod. 9:13 before 7th plague -- that they may serve Me
Exod. 10:3 before 8th plague -- that they may serve Me

* Pharaoh Considered Letting Them Go

Exod. 8:25 4th -- go sacrifice to your God in the land
 28 go in the wilderness -- not very far
Exod. 9:28 7th -- I will let you go
Exod. 10:8,11 8th -- go serve the Lord
Exod. 10:24 9th -- go serve the Lord -- (no flocks & herds)
Exod. 12:31-32 10th -- go serve the Lord -- (take your flocks)

*Shall Know That I Am the Lord -- seeing the plagues

Exod. 7:17 turning water into blood
Exod. 8:10 frogs
 22 swarms of flies
Exod. 9:14 all My plagues
 29 no more hail
Exod. 10:2 My signs which I have done among you
Exod. 11:7 difference between Egyptians and Israel

*Shall Know That I Am the Lord -- Deliverance from Egypt

Exod. 6:7 to the children of Israel -- you shall know that I am the Lord your God -- who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians
Exod. 7:5 Egyptians shall know -- when I bring out the children of Israel from among them
Exod. 14:4 I will gain honor over Pharaoh and over all his army -- that the Egyptians may know that I am the Lord
 18 the Egyptians shall know that I am the Lord -- when

I have gained honor for Myself over Pharaoh,
his chariots and his horsemen
