*Of the 150 psalms, David wrote 75 of them -- 73 are attributed to David in the superscription -- and another 2 (Psalms 2 and 95) are ascribed to David in the New Testament

Psalms 5:1 give ear to my words -- consider my meditation
2 give heed to the voice of my cry
3 you will hear my voice -- in the morning
4 You do not take pleasure in wickedness -- nor shall
evil dwell with You
5 the boastful shall not stand in Your sight -- You hate
all workers of iniquity
6 You shall destroy those who speak falsehood -- the
Lord abhors the bloodthirsty and deceitful
man
Psalm 7:1-2 in You I put my trust -- save me from all those
who persecute me -- deliver me, lest they
tear me in pieces like a lion
Psalm 10:1 why do You stand afar off? -- why do You hide in times
of trouble?
2 the wicked in his pride persecutes the poor -- let
them be caught in the plots which they have
devised
3 the wicked boasts of his heart's desire -- he blesses
the greedy and renounces the Lord
4 the wicked in his proud countenance does not seek God
-- God is not in his thoughts
Psalm 15:1-5 who may abide in His tabernacle?
3 he who does not backbite with his tongue -- he who
does not evil to his neighbor
Psalm 21:7 the king who trusts in the Lord
8 God's hand will find all His enemies -- His right
hand will find those who hate God
9 God shall make them as a fiery oven in the time of
His anger -- the Lord will swallow them up
in His wrath
10 He shall destroy their offspring from the earth
11 they intended evil against God
Psalm 23:4 yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow
of death, I will fear no evil -- for You
are with me -- Your rod and Your staff, they

comfort me
 Psalm 34:13 keep your tongue from evil -- keep your lips from
 speaking deceit
 14 depart from evil & do good -- seek peace
 15 the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous -- His
 ears are open to their cry
 16 face of the Lord is against those who do evil
 21 evil shall slay the wicked
 Psalm 35:1 plead my cause, Oh Lord, with those who strive with
 me -- fight against those who fight against
 me
 4 let those who seek after my life be put to shame and
 brought to dishonor -- let those be turned back and brought to confusion
 12 reward me evil for good -- (sorrow of my soul)
 13 as for me -- when they were sick, my clothing was
 sackcloth -- humbled myself (fasting)
 14 I paced about as though he were my friend or brother
 -- I bowed down heavily, as one who mourns
 for his mother
 15 but in my adversity, they rejoiced and gathered
 together -- attackers gathered against me,
 and I did not know it -- they tore at me and
 did not cease
 16 with ungodly mockers at feast, they gnashed at me with
 their teeth
 17 Lord, how long will You look on? -- rescue me from
 their destructions -- from the lions
 19 let them not rejoice over me who are wrongfully my
 enemies
 20 for they do not speak peace -- but they devise
 deceitful matters against the quiet ones
 in the land
 21 they also opened their mouth wide against me, & said,
 "Aha, aha; our eyes have seen it"
 22 You have seen this Oh, Lord -- do not keep silence
 -- do not be far from me
 23 stir up Yourself and awake to my vindication and to
 my cause
 24 vindicate me -- let them not rejoice over me
 26 exalt themselves against me -- let those be ashamed
 and brought to mutual confusion -- clothed with shame and dishonor
 27 let those who favor my righteous cause -- shout for
 joy and be glad
 28 and my tongue shall speak of Your righteousness --
 and of Your praise all the day long
 Psalm 37:7 rest in the Lord -- wait patiently for Him -- do not
 fret because of those who bring wicked
 schemes to pass
 8 cease from anger -- forsake wrath -- do not fret --
 it only causes harm
 9 evildoers shall be cut off -- those who wait on the
 Lord shall inherit the earth
