### \* JERICHO

Heb. 11:30 by faith -- the walls of Jericho fell after they were encircled for 7 days

Josh. 6:1 Jericho was securely shut up  
2 God told Joshua -- I have given Jericho (king and mighty men) into your hand  
3 you shall march around the city -- all the men of war -- you shall go all around the city once -- you shall do this for 6 days  
4 7 priests and 7 trumpets -- on 7th day, you shall march around the city 7 times  
5 a long blast with the ram's horn -- when you hear the sound of the trumpet, all the people shall shout with a great shout -- the wall of the city will fall down flat  
6 Joshua told priests -- take up the ark of the covenant -- 7 priests & 7 trumpets  
7 Joshua said -- proceed -- march around city -- let him who is armed, advance before the ark of the Lord  
10 Joshua -- don't shout until I instruct to shout  
11 the ark of the Lord -- circled the city  
12 rose early -- priests took up the ark of Lord  
13 7 priests & 7 trumpets -- continually blew  
14 marched around the city -- 1 time for 6 days  
15 7th day -- around city 7 times  
16 during the 7th time, Joshua said to shout  
17 the city shall be doomed -- only Rahab (and those in her house) shall live -- because she hid the messengers that were sent  
22 Joshua said to the 2 spies -- go to Rahab's house to bring out the woman and all [the family] that she has  
25 Joshua spared Rahab -- because she hid the messengers whom Joshua sent to spy out Jericho

\* RAHAB

\* First -- notice some scriptures

Exod. 1:22	Pharaoh's edict
Dan. 3:3-6	Nebuchadnezzar's edict
13-14	repeated to the 3
18	their response
Rev. 13:1,11	2 beasts
15-17	image of beast -- mark, name, number
Rev. 20:4	beast, image, mark

\* Now -- back to Rahab

Hebrews 11:31      by faith -- the harlot Rahab did not perish with those who did not believe -- when she had received the spies with peace

Josh. 2:1	Joshua sent out 2 men from Acacia Grove -- to view the land, especially Jericho -- the spies lodged at the house of Rahab
2	the king of Jericho heard about the spies
3	the king sent soldiers to the house of Rahab
4	Rahab hid the 2 spies
6	she hid them on the roof

4	*Yes, the men came to me, but I did not know where they were from
---	---

5	*It happened as the gate was being shut (when it was dark) that the men went out of the gate
---	--

\* Where they went, I do not know

\*Pursue them quickly, for you may overtake them

James 2:25      likewise -- wasn't Rahab justified by works (actions)?  
-- when she received the messengers and sent them out another way
