Psalm 15:1 who may abide in Your tabernacle? -- who may
 dwell in Your holy hill?

* Tabernacle

Exod. 25:8-9 sanctuary -- pattern of the tabernacle
 22 I will meet with you there
Exod. 29:42-45 tabernacle of meeting

* Holy Hill

Isaiah 2:2-4 mountain of the Lord -- out of Zion
Heb. 12:22 Mount Zion -- city of the living God -- the
 heavenly Jerusalem

* Psalm 15:2

Psalm 15:2 walk uprightly -- work righteousness -- speaks
 the truth in his heart

Jer. 17:9-14 heart is deceitful -- wicked
 9 God searches the heart -- tests the mind
 10 false riches
 11 heal me -- save me
 14

Luke 6:39-49 known by the fruit
 43-44 good treasure of the heart
 45 foundation -- rock or sand?
 46-49

* Psalm 15:3

Psalm 15:3 not backbite with the tongue -- not do evil to
 a neighbor -- not slur a friend
Prov. 16:27 ungodly man digs up evil -- and his lips are
 a
 burning fire
 28 perverse man sows strife - whisperer separates
 the best of friends
 29-30 entices his neighbor -- leads astray - devises

* Psalm 15:4

Psalm 15:4 despises vile person -- honors those who fear
 the Lord -- doesn't change an oath

* Despise a vile person

* "contemned" in King James -- "baza" (Strong's #959) -- verb
 to despise, scorn, ridicule
 to show contempt for
 "despised" -- 26 times and "contemned" -- 1 time

* Look up the word "hate"
 "hate" -- "sane" (Strong's #8130) -- verb
 to hate, to be an enemy
 hate can be active -- as an enemy or adversary
 hate can be passive -- someone unloved or shunned
 "hate" (68) -- "hated" (40) -- "hateth" (20) -- "hatest" (5)

Psalm 139:21-22
 19 oh that you would slay the wicked, Oh God
 20 they speak against You wickedly
 21 Do I hate them who hate You? -- Do I loathe
 those who rise up against You?
 22 I hate them with perfect hatred - I count them
 my enemies
 23-24 search me

* Honor those who fear the Lord

Mal. 3:16 spoke to one another -- book of remembrance
 17 "I will make them My jewels"
 18 discern between righteous & wicked -- discern
 between those who serve God and those who
 do not

* Does not change his testimony

Lev. 19:15	no injustice in judgment
16	not a talebearer
17	no hate in your heart -- but a time to rebuke
18	no vengeance or grudge -- love your neighbor
Zech. 8:16	speak truth -- truth, justice and peace
17	think no evil in heart against your neighbor
	-- do not love a false oath

Psalm 15:5	no usury -- no bribes
Ezek. 22:12	bribe -- usury -- extortion - dishonest profit
