Young's Literal Translation of the Holy Bible:

"Do two walk together if they have not met?"

Contemporary English Version:

"Can two people walk together without agreeing to meet?"

Revised Standard Version:

"Do two walk together unless they have made an appointment?"

James Moffatt translation:

"Do two men travel together unless they have planned it?"

Agreements With God Before Baptism

- * My Paradigm -- God as a Perfect Father
 - * The Father decided to have children
- Isaiah 44:2 God made you -- and formed you from the womb
 24 He who formed you from the womb said -- I am the
 Lord who makes all things
- Jer. 1:5 before I formed you in the womb, I knew you --
 before you were born, I sanctified you --
 I ordained you a prophet to the nations
- Gal. 1:15 when it pleased God (who separated me from my

- * The Father decided to love us
- * The Father decided to keep us safe
- * The Father built a relationship with us
- * We learned to trust the Father

- * The Father taught us principles for happiness
- * The Father told us about His expectations
- * The Father taught us about loving consequences
- * The Father talked to us -- listened to us

* Because of His Mercy -- we repented, were baptized and received the gift of the Holy Spirit
