Amos 3:3          can two walk together, unless they are agreed?

## Young's Literal Translation of the Holy Bible:

"Do two walk together if they have not met?"

Contemporary English Version:

"Can two people walk together without agreeing to meet?"

Revised Standard Version:

"Do two walk together unless they have made an appointment?"

James Moffatt translation:

"Do two men travel together unless they have planned it?"

## Agreements With God After Baptism

- \* My Paradigm -- God as a Perfect Father
- \* We agreed to continue obeying Him

Rom. 6:1 shall we continue in sin?  
2 certainly not  
3 baptized into His death  
4 buried with Him through baptism into death --  
as Christ was raised from the dead by the  
glory of the Father, we shall also walk in  
newness of life

5                    likeness of His death -- also, likeness of His  
                         resurrection

\*            The issue of trust remains important

2 Cor. 1:8           Paul's trouble in Asia -- burdened beyond measure --  
above strength -- despaired even of life  
          9           sentence of death -- not trust in ourselves -- but  
                         trust in God who raises the dead  
          10          has delivered -- does deliver -- will deliver

\*            The Father still wants us to talk to Him

Gen. 18:23-33           willing to talk with Him -- even negotiate  
Luke 11:5-8           willing to talk with Him -- persist in prayer  
Luke 18:1-7           willing to talk with Him -- persist in prayer

\*            We continue to grow

Heb. 5:12-14           no longer babies -- maturing

\*            Have you ever experienced something like a "Road  
to Damascus" experience?

\*            If not literally -- figuratively?

\*            For the record -- I am not asking you to be  
                 re-baptized over and over again

Acts 9:4-6           a "road to Damascus" experience  
          17           filled with the Holy Spirit  
          18           baptized  
Heb. 5:7-8           the Son of God learned obedience -- by the things which  
He suffered

\*            2 valuable lessons
