night picturing when He was betrayed

1 Cor. 11:23 on the night in which He was betrayed

*This is my 50th year to keep the Commemoration of
the Suffering and Death of Our Lord -- with the
New Testament symbols of the foot-washing,
broken bread and a sip of wine

1 Cor. 11:23-26 broken bread -- cup of wine

- * My view of those two items has NOT change!!!!
- * Rather -- My view of Old Testament history has change
- * Before 2014 was "early 14" -- After 2014 was "later 14"

Exod. 12:2 the first month of the year
 6 on the 14th day of the same month
 18 on the 14th day of the month -- at evening

1. Christ is my Passover

1 Cor. 5:7 Christ our Passover was sacrificed for us

2. Christ died at 3:00 p.m.

Matt. 27:45 6th hour to 9th hour -- noon to 3:00 p.m.
 46 9th hour -- 3:00 p.m.

3. "Sanctuary" Passover -- Tabernacle and Temple

Exod. 12:7 Exodus Passover -- "domestic" Passover -- home
 48 "let him come near"
Exod. 25:21 mercy seat on top of the ark
 22 "I will meet with you there"
Exod. 29:42 "where I will meet you to speak with you"

43 "there I will meet with the children of Israel"
 44 Aaron and sons as priests
 45 I will dwell among the children of Israel"
 Num. 9:2 keep the Passover at its appointed time
 3 14th day of this month -- at twilight
 4 Moses told the children of Israel that they
 should keep the Passover
 5 14th day of first month -- at twilight
 7 defiled -- kept from presenting the offering
 --(dealing with the sanctuary)
 Deut. 16:1 keep the Passover
 2 "in the place where God chooses"
 5 "not within your gates"
 6 "at the place where God chooses to make His name abide"
 7 "in the place where God chooses"
 2 Chron. 30:26 Hezekiah -- there had been nothing like this in
 Jerusalem, since the time of Solomon
 2 Chron. 35:18 Josiah -- there was no passover kept in Israel
 like this, since the days of Samuel
 2 Kings 23:21 as it was written in the book of the covenant
 24 words of the law -- written in the book
 25 according to all the law of Moses
 2 Chron. 30:24 Hezekiah gave animals to the congregation
 * 1,000 bullocks
 * 7,000 sheep
 others gave animals to the congregation
 * 1,000 bullocks
 * 10,000 sheep
 2 Chron. 35:7 Josiah gave animals for the passover offering
 * 30,000 sheep and goats
 * 3,000 bullocks
 8 leaders gave animals for the passover offering
 * 2,600 sheep
 * 300 bullocks
 9 others gave animals for the passover offering
 * 5,000 sheep
 * 500 cattle
 Exod. 12:42 "night to be remembered"
 "night to be much observed"
 "night of solemn observance"
 "night of watching"

* What are names of the New Testament observance?
 1 Cor. 11:20 "Lord's supper" -- but, we don't have a meal
 * "Last supper" -- but, we don't have a meal
 * "Commemoration" -- from 2014 to 2020
 * Memorial
 * Mark 14:1-9 -- memorial to her

* Memorial to the Son of God

1 Cor. 5:8 and then -- the Feast of Unleavened Bread
