Mark 14:12-17 disciples arranged a meal  
(called it "Passover")  
18-21 discussed the betrayal  
22-25 discussed the bread and wine  
26 they went to Mount of Olives  
27 "all will stumble" -- (Zechariah 13:7)  
28 "after I have been raised, I will go before you to  
Galilee"  
29 Peter -- "I will not be made to stumble"  
30 Christ -- "you will deny Me 3 times"  
31 "we will not deny You"  
32-42 prayer in Gethsemane  
43-49 Judas -- identifying kiss  
50 they all forsook Him  
53-54 the soldiers led Him away to high priest  
55-64 they sought to kill Him -- they sought false  
witnesses  
65 spit and hit

66-72 Peter denied Him 3 times  
Mark 15:1 in the morning

Reading from Mark's account

Mark 15:1 in the morning  
1-5 chief priests and council -- took Him to Pilate  
6-15 the chief priests stirred up the crowd -- to  
release Barabbas  
16 whole garrison of soldiers  
17 crown of thorns  
18 saluted Him -- mocking  
19 hit Him in the head -- spit on Him  
20 mocked Him  
21 Simon carried His cross  
22 arrived at Golgotha  
23 offered Him wine (sedative) -- He refused  
24 divided His garments  
25 3rd hour (9:00) -- they crucified Him  
26 "King of the Jews"  
27-28 2 robbers crucified with Him  
29-30 rubber-neckers taunted Him  
31-32 chief priests mocked Him  
33 6th hour (noon) til 9th hour (3:00) -- darkness  
34 9th hour (3:00) -- "My God, My God; why have You  
forsaken Me?"  
35-36 some people thought that He was calling for  
Elijah  
37 breathed His last breath  
38 veil of temple was torn  
39 centurion -- "Truly, this Man was the Son of God"
