 6 lusting -- Numbers 11:1-33
 7 idolatry
 8 sexual immorality
 9 tempting Christ -- Numbers 21:5-6
 10 murmuring -- Numbers 14:2-37

## 1. Lusting, Murmuring & Tempting Christ

Exod. 16:1 15th day of the 2nd month  
2-3 murmured against Moses and Aaron in wilderness  
-- we wish God had killed us in Egypt; we  
could have eaten well before we died  
6-8 Moses and Aaron said -- who are we that you murmur  
against us? -- your murmurings are not against us, but against God  
35 they ate manna for 40 years -- (Josh. 5:12)  
Exod. 17:3 against Moses -- is this why you brought us out of  
Egypt? -- to kill us?  
4 Moses cried out to God  
5-6 strike the rock -- water will come forth  
Num. 11:1 when the people complained, it displeased God  
-- the fire of God consumed them in the  
uttermost parts of the camp  
2-3 when Moses prayed, the fire was quenched  
4-5 lusting for the fish, cucumbers, melons, leeks,  
onions and garlic of Egypt  
6-9 they were tired of the manna  
10 God was angry -- Moses was displeased  
11-15 Moses complained  
16-17 God stated His intention to choose 70 elders  
18-20 God stated His intention to give them meat  
21-23 Moses wondered how -- "is My hand waxed short?"  
24-30 70 elders were chosen  
31-32 God sent quail  
33 a great plague  
Num. 14:2 complained -- it would have been better to die  
in Egypt than in this wilderness

3                   complained -- God brought us into this land to  
                     die and for our wives & children to be a  
                     prey -- be better to return to Egypt  
 4                   let's make a captain and go back to Egypt  
 5                   Moses and Aaron bowed down to pray  
 6-9               Joshua and Caleb responded well  
 10               the people wanted to stone Moses and Aaron  
 11-12           God talked about making a nation through Moses  
 13-19           Moses reminded God of His mercy  
 19               Moses -- pardon the sin of Your people because of Your  
                     mercy  
 20               God -- I have pardoned according to your word  
 22-23           God -- because they have tempted Me these 10  
                     times, they will not see the land  
 24               God -- Caleb shall see the promised land  
 26-35           God described His punishment  
 27               God -- I have heard your murmurings  
 28-30           God -- the carcasses of those over 20 years of  
                     age who murmured against Me shall fall in  
                     wilderness -- except for Caleb and Joshua  
 31               God -- the little ones (whom you said would be a prey)  
                     shall inherit the promised land  
 32-35           God -- your carcasses shall fall; your children  
                     shall wander in wilderness for 40 years  
 36-37           the 10 men who brought the evil report died  
 Num. 16:1-3     Levites complained that Moses and Aaron took too  
                     much responsibility and authority  
 7               Moses -- you Levites take too much upon you  
 10               Moses -- do you also seek the priesthood?  
 Heb. 3:1-6     Moses is a type of Jesus Christ  
 Num. 21:4       while journeying, the people were discouraged  
 5               they spoke against God and against Moses -- why  
                     did you bring us out of Egypt? -- did you  
                     bring us here to die?  
 6               God sent fiery serpents  
 7               people -- we sinned against God and against you  
  
 \*               New Testament Warning  
  
 Heb. 3:7-19     harden not your hearts  
 16               some who came out of Egypt provoked God  
 17-19           sinned -- told they would not enter -- unbelief
