Psalms 141:3 set a guard, Oh Lord, over my mouth -- keep watch
over the door of my lips
John 8:44 you are of your father, the devil -- murderer
from the beginning -- he is a liar, and the
father of lies
Gen. 3:4 serpent -- direct lie
5 serpent -- told a lie to create doubt

* Lessons from the Proverbs

Prov. 10:19 in the multitude of words, sin is not lacking
-- he who refrains his lips is wise
Prov. 11:12 a man of understanding holds his peace
13 a talebearer reveals secrets -- a faithful spirit
conceals a matter
Prov. 15:28 the heart of the righteous studies to answer --
the mouth of the wicked pours forth evil
Prov. 17:27 he who has knowledge spares his words -- a man
of understanding is of a calm spirit
28 even a fool is counted wise when he holds his
peace -- when he shuts his lips, he is
considered perceptive
Prov. 18:13 he who answer a matter before he hears it, it
is folly and a shame to him
Prov. 20:19 he who goes about as a talebearer reveals secrets
-- therefore, do not associate with one who flatters with his lips
Prov. 21:23 he who guards his mouth and tongue, keeps his
soul from trouble
Prov. 26:20 where there is no wood, the fire goes out -- and
where there is no talebearer, strife ceases
Prov. 29:11 a fool vents all his feelings, but a wise man
holds them back
20 do you see a man hasty in his words? -- there
is more hope for a fool than for him
