* A Change of Heart

Matt. 12:34-35 out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks
-- good treasure -- evil treasure
Eph. 4:13 the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of
the Son of God -- to a perfect (mature) man
-- to the measure of the stature of the
fullness of Christ
14 no longer children -- not tossed to and fro --
and not carried about with every wind of
doctrine -- not gullible to the trickery
of men (in the cunning craftiness of
deceitful plotting)
15 speaking the truth in love
16 part of the edifying body
Eph. 4:26 be angry and sin not -- don't let the sun go down
on your wrath
27 don't give place to the devil -- Romans 12:19
28 stay busy
29 let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth
-- but say what is good for necessary
edification -- that it might impart grace
to the hearers
30 don't grieve the Holy Spirit of God
31 put away -- bitterness, wrath, anger, clamor,
evil speaking, malice
32 kind -- tenderhearted -- forgiving
James 3:1 be not many masters -- greater condemnation
2 often offend -- seek to bridle the whole body
3 bits in horses' mouth
4 small helms guide ships
5 the tongue is a little part of the body -- that
boasts great things -- a little fire can
burn many things
6 the tongue is a fire -- defiles the whole body
7-8 mankind can tame many things -- no person can
tame the tongue -- it is an unruly evil,
full of deadly poison
9-12 out of the mouth -- blessing and cursing
13 good conduct -- works done in meekness
14-16 no bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts
