- * Before I begin discussing some scriptures, let me mention one of my favorite verses to you

Jeremiah 23:16 thus says the Lord of hosts -- do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you -- they make you worthless -- they speak a vision of their own heart, not from the mouth of the Lord

Rev. 14:9-11 3rd angel
If anyone worships the beast and his image and receives his mark on his forehead or on his hand, he himself shall also drink of the wine of the wrath of God (which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation) He shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb
And the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever; and they have no rest day or night (those who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name)

 * Over his image

 standing on the sea of glass -- harps of God
 Rev. 16:1 to the 7 angels -- "Go and pour out the bowls
 of the wrath of
 God on the earth"
 2 1st angel poured out his bowl of God's wrath
 -- a foul &
 loathsome sore came upon the men who had
 the mark of the beast & those who
 worshipped his image
 Rev. 19:20 the beast was captured & also the false prophet
 (who worked
 signs in his presence by which he deceived
 those who received the mark of the beast
 & those who worshipped his image) -- these
 two were cast alive into the lake of fire
 (burning with brimstone)
 Rev. 20:4 I saw thrones, and they sat on them -- judgment
 was committed
 to them -- then I saw the souls of those
 who had been beheaded
 * for their witness to Jesus
 * for the word of God
 * had not worshipped the beast or his image
 * had not received his mark on their
 foreheads
 or their hands
 Rev. 20:4 they lived & reigned with Christ of 1,000 years
