Rev. 20:11-12 I saw the dead (small and great) -- standing before God -- book were opened -- Book of Life opened

Rev. 20:1-3 devil was bound

Isaiah 2:2-4 the Lord's house exalted above all -- people wanted to be taught -- the word of the Lord went forward from Jerusalem -- way of peace (swords into plowshares)

Jer. 31:12 goodness of the Lord -- physical blessings (wheat, new wine, oil, young of the flock and herd) -- emotional blessings (souls like a well-watered garden -- they shall sorrow no more at all)
