   Him -- being abominable, disobedient and  
   disqualified for every good work

- \* TWO FALSE TEACHINGS

Gal. 2:4                      examine the verse  
   \* False brethren -- secretly brought in  
   \* Who came in by stealth to spy out our  
   liberty  
   \* Liberty which we have in Christ Jesus  
   \* That they might bring us into bondage

Jude 4                      examine the verse  
   \* Certain men -- crept in unnoticed  
   \* Ungodly men  
   \* Turned grace of God into lewdness  
   \* Deny God and our Lord Jesus Christ

1. USING THE BEAUTIFUL LAW AS A WEAPON OF BONDAGE
2. USING GRACE AS A MEANS TO ELIMINATE CONSEQUENCES

Rom. 6:1-2              does grace allow for sin to abound?  
Rom. 7:14              the law is spiritual -- I am sold under sin  
Gal. 5:1              stand fast in your liberty -- and do not be  
entangles again with a yoke of bondage  
   2              physical circumcision -- not necessary  
   8              this persuasion -- not from Him who calls you  
   9              a little leaven, leavens the whole lump  
   -- (1 Corinthians 5:1-13)  
   12              those who trouble you -- cut themselves off  
Titus 1:10              idle talkers and deceivers (especially those of the  
   circumcision)  
   14              not giving heed to Jewish fables & commandments of  
   men -- or men who turn from the truth  
Titus 3:4-7              saved by grace  
   8              expectations  
Gal. 2:6-10              conflict -- Jewish converts & Gentile converts  
   6              "seemed to be something" - "makes no difference  
   to me"  
   7-8              Peter and Paul -- different audiences  
   9              James, Peter, John -- right hand of fellowship
