—

Matt. 24:15	"standing in the holy place"
Mark 13:14	"standing where it ought not"
Luke 21:20	when you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies, know that the desolation is near

—

Matt. 24:16	then, let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains
Mark 13:14	same as Matt. 24:16
Luke 21:21	those who are in Judea flee to the mountains -- let those who are in the middle of her [Jerusalem], depart -- and those who are in the country, do not enter into her [Jerusalem]
22	for those are the days of vengeance -- that all things that are written may be fulfilled

—

Matt. 24:17	on housetop -- do not go down into the house to take anything out of the house
18	in the field -- not go back to get your clothes
Mark 13:15	same as Matt. 24:17
16	same as Matt. 24:18
Luke 21	did not mention housetop or field, however.....
Luke 17:31	mentioned housetop and field

—

Matt. 24:19	woe to those who are pregnant -- woe to those who are nursing babies
Mark 13:17	same as Matt. 24:19
Luke 21:23	same as Matt. 24:19 -- added -- for there will be great distress in the land and wrath upon this people

—

Matt. 24:20 pray that your flight may not be in winter --
 or on the Sabbath
Mark 13:18 pray that your flight may not be in winter
Luke 21 no reference to fleeing in winter or on Sabbath

Matt. 24:21 there will be great tribulation -- such as has
 not been seen since the beginning of the
 world until this time -- never shall be
Mark 13:19 in those days, there will be tribulation, such as has
 not be since the beginning of the creation
 (which God has created) -- nor ever shall
 be
Luke 21:24 and they will fall by the edge of the sword, and be
 led away captive into all nations --
 Jerusalem will be trampled by Gentiles
 until the times of the Gentiles fulfilled

—
Matt. 24:22 unless those days be shortened, no flesh would
 be saved -- but for the elect's sake, those
 days will be shortened
Mark 13:20 and unless the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh
 would be saved -- but for the elect's sake
 (whom He chose), He shorten-ed the days

—
Matt. 24:23 "look, here is the Christ" or "there is the
Christ" -- do not believe it
 24 false Christ and false prophets shall arise --
 great signs and wonders -- if possible, to
 deceive the elect
 25 I have told you ahead of time
Mark 13:21-23 same as Matt. 24:23-25

—
Matt. 24:26-28 not mentioned in Mark 13 or Luke 21
 26 "look, He is in the desert"; do not go out --
 "look, He is in the inner rooms"; do not
 believe it
 27 lightning east to west -- coming of Son of Man
 28 wherever the carcass ("ptoma" -- #4430) is, the
 eagles will be gathered together
Luke 17:37 compare Matt. 24:28 and Luke 17:37
 a difference -- "body" ("soma" -- #4983)

- * Both say "eagles" -- (same word for eagle or vulture)
 eagles -- "aetos" [#105] -- eagle or vulture
- * Difference between "carcass" and "body"
 carcass -- "ptoma" [#4430] -- dead body, corpse
 body -- "soma" [#4983] -- a body
- * Revised Standard -- body -- eagles (margin says vultures)
- * New American Standard -- corpse -- vultures
- * James Moffatt -- carcass -- vultures
