 - * Supplication -- almost always involves intense prayer

- * Notice words about "prayer"

- * "proseuche" (4335) -- noun
 - listed as -- prayer
 - King James -- 37 times
 - * "proseuchomai" (4336) -- verb
 - listed as -- to pray
 - King James -- 87 times
-
- * Notice words about supplication
-
- * "deesis" (1162) -- noun
 - listed as -- prayer, request, petition
 - King James -- 19 times
 - prayer -- 7 times
 - prayers -- 5 times
 - supplication -- 4 times
 - supplications -- 2 times
 - request -- 1 time
 - * "hiketeria" (2428) -- noun
 - listed as -- petition, supplication
 - King James -- only one time
 - supplications -- Hebrews 5:7

| Luke 5:33 | scribes & Pharisees -- why do the disciples of John fast often and make prayers (1162), but You eat and drink? |
| Acts 1:13-14 | the 11 disciples and the family of the Christ |

 (4335) and supplication (1162)

 (4335) -- night and day
 1 Pet. 3:12 Peter -- the eyes the Lord are on the righteous
 and His ears are open to their prayers

Luke 22:41-44 Christ -- intense prayer
 41 Christ kneeled down and prayed (4336)
 44 being in agony, he prayed (4336) more earnestly --
 His sweat was like great drops of blood
 falling down to the ground
 Heb. 5:7 Christ -- offered up prayers (1162) and
 supplications (2428)

People

Rom. 10:1 Paul -- my heart's desire and prayer (1162) to
 God is that Israel might be saved
 2 Cor. 1:11 Paul -- acknowledged prayer (1162) for him
 8 despaired even for our life
 9 sentence of death in ourselves
 10 has delivered -- does deliver -- will deliver
 2 Cor. 9:14 Paul -- their prayer (1162) for you -- (saints
 in physical need) -- "who long for you"
 Eph. 6:18 Paul -- praying (4336) always with all prayer
 (4335) & supplication (1162) -- watching
 with all perseverance and supplication
 (1162) for all saints
 Phil. 1:4 Paul -- every prayer (1162) on mine -- making
 request for you all with joy
 Phil. 1:19 Paul -- my deliverance will come by your prayer (1162)
 and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ
 1 Tim. 2:1 Paul exhorted -- that supplications (1162), prayers
 (4335), intercessions and giving of thanks be made for all people
 2 Tim. 1:3 Paul -- I make mention of you (Timothy) without ceasing
 in my prayers (1162) -- night and day
 James 5:16 James -- pray for one another -- the effective fervent
 prayer (1162) of a righteous man avails much
