Family history -- of Ishmael and Isaac Gen. 12:2-3 God promised blessings through Abram's family Abram was 75 Gen. 15:2-3 Abram to God -- childless -- no offspring God promised blessings through Abram's family 4 - 5Gen. 16:1-4 Sarai convinced Abram to have children with her handmaiden, Hagar 11-12 prophecy about Ishmael 15-16 Abram was 86 when Ishmael was born Gen. 17:1-14 Abram was 99 -- God promised blessings through Abram's family Abram asked if the blessings could come through Ishmael God promised a son named Isaac 20-21 God blessed Ishmael and his descendants, but God promised a covenant through Isaac Gen. 21:12-13 God reminded Abraham that He would make a great nation through Ishmael

2 "you shall have no inheritance"
3 banded together -- raiding
4-11 they approached him to lead them against the children of Ammon
12 Jephthah sent messengers -- why do you want to start a war?
13 king of Ammon replied -- because Israel took away our land

14-22Jephthah gave the history

15 Israel did not take the lands of Moab or Ammon 16-19Israel requested to pass through the lands

God promised blessings through Isaac

- 20 Sihon, king of the Amorites, attacked Israel 21-22God gave Israel the land of the Amorites for 300 year, Israelites have been living in this land -- if the land really belonged to you, why did you wait so long to retrieve it?
