- * Hebrew -- "ap" (Strong's #639)
 "hot of nose" signifies anger -- ("long of nose" --
 patience; "high of nose" -- arrogance)
 translated "anger" -- 171 times in Old Testament
 translated "wrath" -- 42 times in Old Testament
- * Hebrew -- "kaas" (Strong's #3707) -- verb
 provoke to anger -- around 42 times in Old Testament
- * Greek -- "orge" (Strong's #3709) -- wrath, anger
 wrath -- 31 times.....anger -- 3 times
- * Greek -- "thymos" (Strong's 2372) -- wrath, fury, anger, rage
 wrath -- 14 times
