- * At this time, let's ask a few related question
- * Does the God of grace have expectations? Yes
- * Doesn't grace eliminate expectations? No
- * Doesn't grace negate the concept of expectations? No
- 1 Cor. 5:7 purge out the old leaven (that you may be a new lump)
 -- since you are truly unleavened -- for indeed, Christ our Passover, was sacrificed for us
- 8 not malice & wickedness -- sincerity & truth
- Romans 6:1 shall we continue to sin that grace may abound?
 - 2 certainly not
 - 3 baptized into Christ's death
 - 4 buried with Him in baptism -- raised from the dead by the glory of God
 - 5 likeness of death -- likeness of resurrection
 - 6 no longer slaves of sin
