Luke 14:26-33 Son of God speaking

if a person does not put the Son of God before family
-- "he cannot be My disciple"

"whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple"

Moffatt Translation -- "whoever does not carry his own cross and come after Me, he cannot be a disciple of mine"

Revised Standard Version -- "whoever does not bear his own cross and come after Me, cannot be My disciple"

New American Standard Bible -- "whoever does not carry his own cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple"
