Acts 16:23 24 25-34 35 36 37 us into prison, Romans"	Paul and Silas beaten thrown into prison inner prison fastened their feet in stocks at midnight escape from prison became day magistrate said "let them go" keeper of prison reported those words to Paul Paul they have beaten us openly and have thrown now they want to let us out privately "innocent"
38	officers told these words to the magistrates they were afraid when they heard that they were Romans [citizens with rights]
Acts 22:1-21 22	Paul was giving his testimony they said "Away with such a fellow from the earth, for he is not fit to live"
23	they tore off their clothes and threw dust into the air
24	the commander ordered that Paul be brought back to the barracks and be examined by scour-ging wanting to learn why they said such things against him
25	Paul is it lawful for you to scourge a man who is a Roman, an innocent Roman?
26	centurion told the commander be careful what you do, because this man is a Roman [with rights]
27	commander asked are you a Roman?
28	commander so am I; I obtained my citizenship with a large sum of money Paul said I was born a citizen
29	those who were about to examine him withdrew from him  the commander was also afraid after he discovered that he had bound up a Roman citizen
