* Some Disciples Have a Meal

John 13:2,4 and supper being ended -- He rose from supper
1 Cor. 11:20-22 Lord's supper
21 his own supper
22 don't you have houses in which to eat & drink?

* Is a meal required on the night picturing when
Jesus was betrayed?

* If it is important for a disciple to have a meal
that night, it is likely that he would observe the event in his own
home--with his family

* Sometimes, a disciple may find some scattered
brethren who organize a private meal with
friends at the event picturing the night
when Christ was betrayed

* Most congregations in our circle of the Church
of God do not include a meal in their
congregational observance picturing the
night when Christ was betrayed

John 13:1-4 after supper
5-17 He washed the feet of the disciples
Matt. 20:25-28 a servant

* Broken Bread

Matt. 26:26 "take, eat; this is My body
Matt. 26:36-44 prayer
45-46 "he who betrays Me is at hand"
1 Cor. 11:23-24 "do this in remembrance of Me"

* Wine

Matt. 26:27-28 "drink from it"
Matt. 27:15-26 Barabbas

1 Cor. 11:25-26 "do this in remembrance of Me"
