- Eph. 2:8-9 saved by grace
- 10 good works
- Titus 3:4-7 justified by grace
- 8 good works
- * Example of the Son of God
- John 4:34 to do His will and to finish His work
- John 5:16 sought to kill Him, because He had done these things (healing) on the Sabbath
- 17 "My Father has been working until now, and I have been working"
- 18 broke the Sabbath -- saying that God was His Father (making Himself equal with God)
- 19-23 Father and Son
- * Do you view God as your Father?
- Romans 8:14-17 Paul wrote
- 14 these are the sons of God
- 15 spirit of bondage to fear -- Spirit of sonship
- 16 children of God
- 17 heirs of God -- heirs with Christ -- suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together
- * Spend this week remembering what are the expectations of your Father
- Mark 12:28-34 scribes and Christ
- 28 scribe -- "what is the first commandment of all?"
- 29-31 Jesus -- mentioned two
- 32-33 scribe reaction -- "is more than all the whole [system] of burnt offerings & sacrifices"
- 34 Jesus -- "you are not far from the Kingdom of God"

Exod. 20:1-2 because I brought you out of Egypt -- REACTION
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 3 no other gods before God
 4-6 no carved image or likeness -- to bow down to
 worship them or to serve them
 7 do not take the name of God in vain
 8-11 remember the Sabbath day -- to keep it holy

* Loving Your Neighbor As Yourself

Exod. 20:1-2 because I brought you out of Egypt -- REACTION
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 12 honor your father and mother
 13 shall not murder
 14 shall not commit adultery
 15 shall not steal
 16 shall not bear false witness against neighbor
 17 shall not covet anything that is neighbor's

* What is the Beam in Your Eye?

Matt. 23:13 beware -- doorkeepers to the Kingdom
 15 beware -- proselytes to control
Matt. 7:1-5 beam in your own eye
Matt. 19:16 young man -- what shall I do that I may have
eternal life?
 17 Christ -- if you want to enter into life, keep
 the commandments
 18 young man -- which ones?
 19 Christ -- He mentioned 5 of the 10 Commandments
(Commandments 5-9) -- He summarized them as -- "you shall love your
 neighbor as yourself"
 20 young man -- I have kept those from my youth;
 what do I still lack?
 21 Christ -- go sell what you have and give to the
 poor

Some people believe that verse 21 is a command
to everyone who claims to be a disciple
I believe that verse 21 is NOT a command for every
disciple -- but rather a specific weakness
that this young man had
What is your specific weakness?
What should you be doing? -- beyond keeping the
10 Commandments?
What are the expectations of your Father?
What is your reaction to grace?
