- \* Purpose of Sermon -- To discuss "Daniel 3:17-18"
- \* The subject matter -- True Faith
- \* Through the years, some of you probably remember hearing me describe some of my ideas about "faith"
- \* I believe that many people (including many religious people) have an erroneous view about "faith"
- \* Following are what I believe to be 2 mistakes about "faith"
  - 1. People confuse "faith" and "hope"
- 2. People allow the teachings about "believe" to influence them to accept the "name-it, claim-it" philosophy

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- \*Let's look at some scriptures that influence people to believe that God is required to answer every prayer with a "yes"
- \*Reminder -- A mature parent (who loves his children) is NOT required to answer every request from His children with a "yes" -- no matter how much faith or hope the children have

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\* I believe that one of the best examples to describe "faith" is mentioned in Daniel 3:17-18

\* Daniel 3:17-18 involves the following -Daniel 3:17-18 involves -- "believe"
Daniel 3:17-18 involves -- "God's will"

Dan. 3:1-7 the image of gold
8-18 Daniel's friends disobey the king
17 our God whom we serve is able to deliver us
18 but if our God does not deliver us, let it be
known that we do not serve your gods and
we will not worship the gold image which

## you have set up

1.I believe that God (as a perfect Father) will supply our personal needs -- because He is trustworthy and because He loves us

- 2.I believe that God will often give us the desires of our heart -- because He loves us
- 3.I believe that God sometimes says "no" to our requests (often some desires of our heart) -- because He loves us

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*	God	sometimes	says	"no"		"not	now"		"wait"
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James 4:2 you have not, because you ask not you ask and receive not, because you ask amiss

\* 3 examples of God saying "no"

Deut. 3:23-27 God told Moses "no"

2 Sam. 12:15-23 God told David "no" -- (even though David was fasting when he made his request)

2 Cor. 12:7 thorn in the flesh

Paul asked 3 times -- that it might go away

God told Paul "no" to the specific request -yet God answered in a different manner -Paul accepted God's response
