* Purpose of sermon -- "3 Reasons for Fasting"

*First -- Should Disciples Fast? Luke 5:33 why do Your disciples eat and drink? 34-35 in those days, they will fast Matt. 6:16-18 when you (disciples) fast.... *Second -- What is Fasting? Absolute fasting (Dry fasting) -- willing abstinence from all food and drink for a defined period of time Fasting -- may involve the willing abstinence from all food (while continuing to drink) for a period of time Fasting -- may involve the willing abstinence from specific habits or behaviors (like television, internet, cell phones) for a period of time 1. AFTER -- DEEPER REPENTANCE Luke 18:9-14 repentance -- is more than just fasting 1 Sam. 7:6 Samuel -- we have sinned against God 2 Sam. 12:15-23 David -- beseeching God for his sick son Ahab -- humbled himself before God 1 Kings 21:27-29 Ezra 10:1-6 Ezra -- we have trespassed against our God Neh. 1:4-11 Nehemiah -- confess sins of children of Israel Neh. 9:1-3 children of Israel -- confessed & worshipped Dan. 9:3-19 Daniel -- we have sinned Joel 2:12-14 Joel quoting God -- turn unto Me Jonah 3:5-10 people of Ninevah -- turned from their evil way Acts 9:9 Saul -- responding to the confrontation 2. DURING -- SEEKING HELP DURING A TRIAL Judges 20:21-26 Israel -- after being defeated twice by the Benjamites, the children of Israel went to the house of God and fasted Ezra 8:21-23 Ezra -- seeking protection 2 Chron. 20:3-4 Jehoshaphat (Judah) -- approaching army Esther 4:1-3 Mordecai and the Jews -- mourning 16 Esther and the Jews -- before visiting the king Matt. 17:21 leaves only by prayer & fasting 3. BEFORE -- CONNECTING WITH OUR FATHER Matt. 4:1-11 Christ in the wilderness Exod. 34:28 Moses -- receiving the 10 Commandments Isaiah 58:6-11 serving God and man
