Matt. 2:13-20                Herod killed the children

### 2. TEACHINGS OF THE SON

Luke 24:44-47            opened their understanding  
44            law, prophets, writings  
45            gave understanding  
46            suffer and rise

### 3. ACTIONS OF THE SON

Luke 19:41-44            He wept over the city  
45-46            He demonstrated strength

### 4. SUFFERINGS OF THE SON

Matt. 26:36-39            honest emotion  
38            sorrowful, even to death  
39            cup pass -- Your will

### 5. DEATH OF THE SON

Matt. 27:45-51            the end of His life  
46            "why have You forsaken Me?"  
51            veil of temple

### 6. RESURRECTION OF THE SON

Acts 2:22-36            words on the day of Pentecost

33                   exalted on the right hand

7.     RETURN OF THE SON

Rev. 11:15       7th trumpet -- Kingdom of God  
16-18           24 elders worshipped God

8.     LEADERSHIP OF THE SON DURING THE MILLENNIUM

Rev. 20:1-6       millennium begins  
1-3           devil bound for 1,000 years  
4-6           shall reign with Him for 1,000 years

9.     JUDGMENT BY THE SON

John 5:19-29       the Son said to them  
22           Father has committed all judgment to the Son  
23           honor the Son -- just as honor the Father  
25           the dead will hear the voice of Son of God  
27           authority to execute judgment  
28           those in the grave will hear His voice  
29           resurrection of life -- of judgment

10.    FAITHFULNESS OF THE SON

1 Cor. 15:24-28 then comes the end  
24           then comes the end -- when He delivers the Kingdom  
to God the Father -- when He puts an end to all rule and all authority  
and power  
25           He must reign till He has put all enemies under  
             His feet  
26           the last enemy that will be destroyed is death  
27           when He says He will put all things under His  
             feet, there is one exception  
28           when all things are made subject to the Son, then  
             the Son Himself will also be subject to the  
             Father (who put all things under Him) --  
             that God may be all in all
