- * The Answer -- Let's review Hebrews 9:1-7

Heb. 9:1

1st covenant -- ordinances of divine service -- in an earthly sanctuary

a tabernacle was prepared -- 3 items mentioned

- 1. The golden candlestick of 7 branches
- 2. The golden altar, or the altar of incense
- 3. The altar, or table of the shew-bread -- where the 12 loaves (representing the 12 tribes) were laid before the Lord
- 1. In each branch of the golden candlestick was a lamp -- these were lighted every evening, and extinguished every morning -- they were intended to give light by night
- 2. The altar of incense was of gold -- and a priest, chosen by lot each week, offered incense every morning and evening in a golden censer -- which he may have left on the altar after the completion of the offering
- 3. The table of the shew-bread was covered with plates of gold --on which, they placed 12 loaves in 2 piles every Sabbath

Hebrews 9:3

behind 2nd veil -- called the Holiest of All

- * The 1st veil was at the entrance of the Holy Place -- which separated the temple from the court -- it prevented the people (and even the Levites) from seeing what was in the Holy Place
- * And the second veil separated the Holy Place from the "Holiest of All"

- mercy seat
- 1. The golden altar of incense
- 2. The ark of the covenant overlaid on all sides with gold -
 - the golden pot that had the manna
 - * Aaron's rod that budded

* the tablets of the covenant
3. Above it was the cherubim of glory overshadowing the mercy seat
* The golden pot that had the manna
Exod. 16:1-3 children of Israel complained 4-16 God instructed about the manna 17-32 the manna came as described 33 "take a pot"
34 Aaron laid it up before the Testimony
* Aaron's rod that budded
Num. 17:1 Lord spoke to Moses 2 get a rod from each house 12 rods write each man's name of their rod 3 write Aaron's name on the rod of Levi put them in the tabernacle of meeting before the Testimony 5 I will choose a rod to blossom 6-7 Moses did as instructed 8 Tend of Aaron had sprouted and put forth buds it had produced blossoms, and yielded ripe almonds 9 Moses brought the rods out each man took his

Exod. 24:12 tablets of stone, which God had written Exod. 32:15 the tablets were in Moses' hands 16 the tablets were the work of God 19 Moses was angry and threw the tablets hebroke them at the foot of the mountain
Exod. 34:1-2 "cut two tablets of stone like the first ones, and I will write on these tablets the words that were on the first tablets which you broke" (also, Deut. 10:1-4)
Deut. 31:26 take the book of the Law and put it beside the ark of the covenant
