*What Does God Remember About You?

- * The Bible described that God at times reminded nations that He chose to "forget" them

Jer. 23:39 I will utterly forget you, and I will forsake you and the city that I gave to you -- I will cast you out of My presence

40 I will bring an everlasting reproach upon you, and a perpetual shame which shall not be forgotten

Lam. 5:20 why do You forget us forever and forsake us for so long a time?

21 turn us unto You, and we shall be turned -- renew

our days as of old

22 unless You have utterly rejected us, and are angry against us

- * Yet, the Bible also described that God at times reminded nations that He remembered them

Isaiah 49:14 Zion said -- the Lord has forsaken me -- my Lord

has forgotten me

15 can a woman forget her nursing child (and not have compassion on her son)? -- they may forget, but I will not forget you

- * How do you apply God's words given to nations to your Christian walk with God?

Jer. 31:33 this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel

34 they shall know Me (from least to greatest) -- I will forgive their iniquity -- I will remember

Heb. 10:16-17	<p>their sin no more -- Heb. 10:17 paraphrasing Jeremiah 31:33-34</p> <p>* The Bible described that God reminded nations that He chose to forget their sins, and He wanted them to do the same</p>
Isaiah 43:25	I am He who blots out your transgressions (for My own sake) -- I will not remember your sins
Isaiah 54:4	do not fear, for you shall not be ashamed -- don't be disgraced, for you shall not be put to shame -- for you will forget the shame of your youth -- you shall not remember the reproach of your widowhood any more
Psalm 17:8	keep me as the apple of Your eye
	<p>* God chooses to ignore some things</p>
Psalm 103:8	God's great mercy
9	God does not keep His anger forever
10	God has not dealt with us according to our sins
11	God's mercy -- as high as the heaven is above the earth
12	removed our transgressions -- as far as east from west
13	as a father pities his children, so the Lord pities those who fear Him
	<p>* God chooses to remember some things</p>
Psalm 103:14	He knows our frame -- He remembers that we are dust
Heb. 6:10	God remembers our work and labor of love which we show toward His name -- by serving the saints
