- * QUESTION -- WHO WROTE THE BOOK OF EXODUS?
 - * Biblical references about Moses writing the Pentateuch (Genesis through Deuteronomy)
 - * New Testament references by Christ
 - Mark 12:26 Christ asked -- have you not read in the book of Moses?
 - Luke 20:37 Christ said -- Moses showed in the burning book passage
 - John 5:46-47 Christ -- if you believed Moses, you would have believed Me, because he wrote about Me -- if you do not believe his writings, how will You believe My words?
 - * References by other New Testament individuals
 - John 1:45 Philip said to Nathanael -- we have found Him of Whom Moses wrote in the law
 - Rom. 10:5 Paul wrote -- Moses wrote about the righteousness of the law -- paraphrasing Leviticus 18:5
 - * References in the Book of Exodus
 - Exod. 17:14 God said to Moses -- write this for a memorial in the book and recount it in the hearing of Joshua
 - Exod. 24:3-4 Moses told the people the words of the Lord and wrote the words of the Lord
 - Exod. 34:27 God said to Moses -- write these words
 - * For the record, I believe other people later edited the manuscripts
 - Num. 12:3 (the man Moses was very humble, more than all

men who were on
the face of the earth)

* TWO MAIN SECTIONS OF THE BOOK OF EXODUS

1. Redemption from Egypt -- Exodus 1-18
2. Covenant with God -- Exodus 19-40

 "Jacob" -- but "Israel"

* Stephen told how Israel ended up in Egypt

Acts 7:8-18	Stephen told how Israel ended up in Egypt
8	Abraham -- Isaac -- Jacob (Israel) -- 12 sons
9	the brothers sold Joseph into Egypt
Gen. 37:28	the brothers sold Joseph to the Midianites who took him to

	Egypt
Acts 7:10	God was with Joseph, delivered him from his troubles and gave him favor with Pharaoh -- (Genesis 41:37-45)
	-- called governor (Genesis 42:6)
11	a large famine came -- (Genesis 41:56)
12	Jacob sent his sons to Egypt to buy corn -- (Genesis 42:1-2)
13	the second time, Joseph revealed himself to them (Genesis 45:1-4) -- and Joseph's family became known to Pharaoh (Genesis 45:16)
14	Joseph sent for his father -- (Genesis 45:17-20)
Gen. 46:2-4	in a vision, God told Jacob to go to Egypt
29	Joseph greeted his father

30-34	Joseph prepared for his family to meet Pharaoh
	-- Joseph told

Gen. 47:1-10	Joseph brought his family to Pharaoh
	11 Joseph gave his

Acts 17:15-16	Jacob lived in Egypt, but he did not want to
	be buried in Egypt
	-- Genesis 47:27-31)
Gen. 50:13-14	after Jacob was buried, Joseph and the other
	sons of Israel
	returned to Egypt
Exod. 1:1-6	the names of the children of Israel in Egypt
5	the descendants of Jacob were 70 people --
	Joseph was in Egypt
	already
6	Joseph died
Acts 7:17	the Israelites grew in Egypt -- (Exodus 1:7)
18	another king arose, who did not know Joseph
	(Exodus 1:8)
Gen. 50:15-21	after Jacob died, the brother were afraid that
	Joseph would
	seek revenge against them
24	Joseph told his brothers that God would bring
	them to the land
	that He promised to Abraham, Isaac and
	Jacob
