Exod. 1:7	the children of Israel multiplied
8	a new Pharaoh -- who did not know Joseph
9-14	taskmasters -- hard bondage
15-22	Pharaoh's plan to kill the male children --
	Acts 7:19

* GOD PREPARED MOSES

Exod. 2:1-10	Moses is spared from murder -- Acts 7:20-22
11-12	Moses murdered an Egyptian -- Acts 7:23-28
13-15	news spread -- Pharaoh sought to slay Moses --
	Moses fled to
	the land of Midian -- Acts 7:29
16-22	Moses met a priest of Midian -- Moses dwelt
	there & married one
	of the his daughters
23	Pharaoh died
23-25	the children of Israel cried out because of
	their bondage -- God
	heard them -- God remembered the covenant
	with Abraham (Gen. 12:2-3), with Isaac
	(Gen. 26:2-5) and with Jacob (Gen.
	28:13-15)
Exod. 3:1-6	God appeared unto Moses -- Acts 7:30-35

6	God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob -- cited in Matt. 22:32, Mark 12:26, Luke 20:37 and Acts 7:32
7-10	will deliver -- will send Moses
11-14	I AM WHO I AM
15	God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob
16-22	God gave instructions to tell the elders
19	God foretold Moses about Pharaoh's reactions
Exod. 4:1	Moses knew the people would not believe him
2-9	God gave Moses 3 miracles to show Pharaoh
2-4	#1 -- rod -- into a serpent -- back into a rod
5	God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob
6-7	#2 -- hand -- leprous hand -- normal hand
8-9	#3 -- water into blood
10-12	Moses questioned if he was the right man for the job -- God promised to be with him
13-16	Moses repeated his objection -- God decided to send Aaron as a spokesman
18-20	Moses headed for Egypt
21	God foretold Moses about Pharaoh's reaction -- but I will harden his heart, that he shall not let you go
22-23	God foretold Moses about killing the firstborn of Egypt -- say "Israel is My son, even My firstborn; let My son go or I will slay your son, even your firstborn"
27-28	Moses told Aaron about God's words
29-31	Moses & Aaron told the people about God's words -- the people believed and worshipped

* MOSES WENT TO SEE PHARAOH

Exod. 5:1	Moses quoted God -- Let My People Go
1	Moses & Aaron told Pharaoh -- the God of Israel said, 'Let My people go, that they may hold a feast unto Me in the wilderness' (next time -- there will be a list of how many times Moses

repeated this statement)

2 Pharaoh asked -- who is your God that I should
obey His voice
to let Israel go? -- I do not know God,
nor will I let Israel go

3 3 days' journey -- sacrifice -- (Exod. 3:18)

4-13 Pharaoh's reaction -- no more straw

14-19 the officers of Israel approached Pharaoh

20-21 the officers of Israel blamed Moses & Aaron

22-23 Moses complained to God

Exod. 6:1-13 God renewed His promise unto Moses

1 you will see what I do to Pharaoh

3 God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob

4 I have established My covenant

5 I have heard the groanings

6 tell them -- I will rescue you

7 I will take you as a people -- will be your God

8 I will take you to land I promised

9 the people did not listen to Moses

10-12 Moses -- why would Pharaoh listen to me?

13 God gave a command to Moses and Aaron

28-30 Moses doubted whether Pharaoh would listen

Exod. 7:1-5 God told Moses what He was going to do

5 He said -- the Egyptians shall know that I am
God when I
stretch forth My hand on Egypt and bring
out the children of Israel

7 Moses was 80 -- Aaron was 83
