Exod. 16:1-3		fleshpots of Egypt
4-5		God promised Moses bread from heaven
6-8		Moses and Aaron told the people
9-10		the glory of God appeared in a cloud
11-12		God told Moses -- you shall know that I Am the Lord your God
13-30		gathered on 6 days
31		they called the bread manna
32-36		some manna was preserved
	*	Preserved from Thirst again
Exod. 17:1		no water at Rephidim
2		the people chided Moses
3		the people murmured -- die in wilderness?
4		Moses said -- the people are ready to stone me
5-7		God told Moses to smite the rock
	*	Preserved from Defeat
Exod. 17:8-16		they fought Amalek
11		when Moses held up his hands, they prevailed

* Preserved from Chaos

Exod. 18:1	Jethro -- priest of Midian -- Moses' father-in-law -- heard how
	God brought Israel out of Egypt
2-5	Moses had sent his wife and 2 sons to Midian
6	Jethro sent a message to Moses -- I am bringing your wife and 2
	sons to you
7-8	Moses told Jethro how God delivered them from Pharaoh
9-12	Jethro blessed God -- he took a burnt offering and sacrifices
	to God
13-16	Jethro saw the way Moses administered justice
17-18	Jethro told Moses that his method was not good
19-23	Jethro gave Moses some advice
24-26	Moses followed Jethro's advice
John 5:22	Father delegated responsibility to the Son
27	Father gave authority to the Son
30	the Son is accountable to the Father
Matt. 20:25-28	the example of the Son of God
