* ISRAEL BROKE THE COVENANT

- * Reminder -- Aaron & Hur stayed behind

Exod.24:13	Moses & Joshua -- went up into the mount of God
14	Moses said -- wait here until I return; if you have any

Exod. 31:18 difficulty, you have Aaron & Hur
God was finished communing with Moses

- * The Sin of the People

Exod. 32:1 when the people saw that Moses delayed to come
 down, they
 approached Aaron and asked him to make them
 gods to go before them

2 Aaron told them to gather their earrings

3 the people brought their earrings to Aaron

4 Aaron made a molded calf -- "this is your god,
 Oh Israel, that
 brought you out of the land of Egypt"

5 Aaron built an altar and proclaimed a feast

6 the people offered offerings and "rose to play"

* God's Dialogue With Moses

Exod. 32:7-8	God -- the people have corrupted themselves
9-10	God added -- I am angry enough to consume them, and I will make a great nation of you
11-12	Moses reminded God what other nations would say
13	Moses reminded God about His promises to Abram
14	God let them live

* Moses Came Down the Mountain

Exod. 32:15	Moses and Joshua came down the mountain
15-18	they heard the noise of partying
19	Moses broke the 2 tables of stone
20	Moses burned the calf in the fire, and ground it to powder
21	Moses asked Aaron how it happened
22-24	Aaron responded
25	Moses saw that the people were naked
26-29	Moses commanded the Levites to kill 3,000 people -- including some of their own family -- Moses told the Levites to consecrate themselves to God
30	Moses stated his intention to make an atonement for the sins of the people

* MOSES INTERCEDED FOR ISRAEL

Exod. 32:31 Moses returned to God

Exod. 32:31-32 Moses asked God to forgive the people -- he
 asked God to remove
 his name "out of your book" in exchange
 for the forgiveness of the people
 Psalm 69:28 -- the book of the living
 Dan. 12:1 -- found written in the book
 Luke 10:20 -- names are written in heaven
 Phil. 4:3 -- the book of life
 Rev. 3:5 -- the book of life
 Rev. 13:8 -- the book of life
 Rev. 17:8 -- the book of life
 Rev. 20:12 -- the book of life

Exod. 32:33-34 God -- whoever has sinned against Me, I will
 blot out of My
 book -- take My people to the land that
 I promised -- My angel shall go before you
 -- I will punish them for their sin
 35 God plagued the people, because of what they
 did with the
 calf which Aaron made

Exod. 33:1-3 God said to Moses -- take My people to the land
 that I promised
 -- I will send an angel, but I will not
 be in the midst of you
 4 the people mourned
 5 God told Moses -- tell the children of Israel
 that I could
 easily kill them; but they should take off
 their ornaments and I will decide what to
 do with them
 7 Moses pitched the tabernacle far from the camp
 8-11 God talked to Moses face to face in tabernacle
 -- Joshua
 remained in the tabernacle
 12-13 Moses said to God -- if You want me to lead
 this people, show me
 what You want -- and remember that this
 nation is Your people
 14 God replied -- I will go with you and give you
 peace
 15-16 Moses said -- if You don't go with us, let us
 stay here; but
 if You go with us, every-one will know that
 we are different
 17 God said -- I will do what you have asked
 18 Moses asked -- show me Your glory

10-16	the table -- (Exod. 25:23-30)
17-24	the lampstand -- (Exod. 25:31-40)
25-28	the altar of incense -- (Exod. 30:1-5)
29	oil & incense -- (Exod. 30:22-38)
Exod. 38:1-7	the altar of burnt offering -- (Exod. 27:1-8)
8	the large bronze bowl -- (Exod. 30:17-21)
9-20	hangings for court -- (Exod. 27:9-19)
21-23	Bezaleel and Aholiab completed their work
24-31	this is the sum of the tabernacle
Exod. 39:1-7	the priestly garments -- (Exod. 28:1-14)
8-21	the breastplate -- (Exod. 28:15-29)
22-31	the other garments for the priests -- (Exod. 28:31-43)
32	the people of Israel finished making everything that God told
	Moses
33-41	they brought it all to Moses
42-43	God gave them His blessing

	*	The Glory of God Filled the Tabernacle
Exod. 40:34-38		the glory of God filled the tabernacle
35		Moses was not able to enter
36-37		the people followed the cloud
38		cloud upon the tabernacle by day -- fire on it by night -- in

the sight of the house of Israel --
throughout their journeys
