- * The concept of socialism is often associated with the phrase -- "From each according to his ability, to each according to his needs"
- * According to Wikipedia: [That phrase] is a slogan popularised [sic] by Karl Marx in his 1875 Critique of the Gotha Program. The principle refers to free access and distribution of goods, capital and services. In the Marxist view, such an arrangement will be made possible by the abundance of goods and services that a developed communist system will produce; the idea is that, with the full development of socialism and unfettered productive forces, there will be enough to satisfy everyone's needs."
- * Wikipedia later continued: (1) Nothing in society will belong to anyone, either as a personal possession or as a capital goods, except the things for which the person has immediate use, for either his needs, his pleasures, or his daily work. (2) Every citizen will be a public man, sustained by, supported by, and occupied at the public expense. (3) Every citizen will make his particular contribution to the activities of the community according to his capacity, his talent and his age; it is on this basis that his duties will be determined, in conformity with the distribution laws."
