Acts 4:36 Joses -- who was surnamed Barnabas by the apostles -- Barnabas -- which is interpreted, the son of consolation a Levite -- of the country of Cyprus
37 sold his land -- proceeds to the apostles

son of a prophet

 - * Consolation -- "paraklesis"
"paraklesis" (3874) -- noun
encouragement, comfort, consolation
"parakaleo" (3870) -- verb
to comfort, to encourage
"parakletos" (3875) -- noun
Comforter -- in John 14-16

* Mentioning -- (3874) and (3870)

2 Cor. 1:3 the God of all comfort (3874)
4 who comforts (3870) us in all our tribulation, that
 we may be able to comfort (3870) them which
 are in any trouble -- by the comfort (3874)
 wherewith we are comforted (3870) of God
5 for as the sufferings of Christ abound in us, so our
 consolation (3874) also abounds by Christ
6 when we are afflicted, it's for your consolation
 (3874) -- or when we are comforted (3870),
 it is for your consolation (3874) and
 salvation
7 partakers of sufferings -- partakers also of the
 consolation (3874)

1 Cor. 9:6 Paul mentioned Barnabas as a servant who did not fleece the flock

Col. 4:10 John Mark was his cousin

* Barnabas made a mistake

Gal. 2:11-13 Peter reacted differently to the Gentiles when
some of the circumcision arrived -- so did
Barnabas

* Barnabas made many good decisions

Acts 9:26 Saul was in Jerusalem -- the disciples were
afraid of him

27 Barnabas took Saul to the apostles

Acts 11:19-21 during times of persecution -- believers
scattered to Phoenicia, Cyprus & Antioch

22 they sent Barnabas to Antioch

23 Barnabas encouraged them heart) to continue in the
Lord (with purpose of heart)

24 the disciples viewed Barnabas as -- a good man, full
of the Holy Spirit and full of faith

25 Barnabas departed for Tarsus -- to find Saul

26 Barnabas brought Saul to Antioch -- they taught
together for a year -- the disciples were
first called Christians in Antioch

27-30 Barnabas & Saul took food to Judea

Acts 13:1 in Antioch, there 5 men (prophets & teachers)

2-3 Barnabas & Saul were set apart

5 John Mark traveled with them

6-11 Barnabas & Saul confronted a sorcerer

13 John Mark returned to Jerusalem

16-40 Paul's sermon

46-47 Paul & Barnabas preached boldly

48-49 the Gentiles were glad

50 the Jews stirred up the prominent women and chief
men of the city -- people raised persecution against them

51 they shook off the dust from their feet

Acts 14:12-13 Barnabas & Paul -- Zeus & Hermes (NKJ)

14 Barnabas & Paul -- tore off their clothes

15-18 Barnabas & Paul -- taught about the Living God

19 the Jews from Antioch & Iconium stoned Paul

20 Barnabas and Paul went to Derbe

21 they returned to Lystra, Iconium and Antioch

22 strengthening the disciples

Acts 15:2 Paul & Barnabas to Jerusalem

12 after Peter spoke, Barnabas & Paul spoke

22-25 Judas & Silas went with "our beloved Barnabas
and Paul" to share the news

35 Paul & Barnabas continued in Antioch

36-41 Paul & Barnabas separated

37-38 Paul disapproved of Mark -- (Acts 13:5,13)

39-41 Barnabas took Mark to Cyprus -- Paul took Silas

Gal. 2:1 Paul, Barnabas and Titus to Jerusalem

6-9 James, Peter & John -- right hand of fellowship to

Paul & Barnabas
