\*Purpose of sermon -- To notice scriptures in the Old Testament that describe giving thanks

---

### \* REMEMBER GOD

Deut. 8:10        when you have eaten and are full, then you shall bless  
God -- for all that He has given you  
11        beware that you do not forget God -- and not keeping  
             His instructions  
12-14        lest that when you have been blessed, your heart  
is lifted up and you forget God who brought you out of Egypt  
Ezra 3:11        they praised God, because the foundation of the  
             Lord was laid  
Psalm 100:1-5        enter His gates with thanksgiving  
Psalm 105:1-4        give thanks to the Lord  
Psalm 106:1-2        give thanks to the Lord

---

### \* APPRECIATE PEOPLE

Eccles. 4:9        two are better than one  
10        if one falls, the other will lift up his companion  
-- woe to him who is alone when he falls -- he has no one to help  
him up  
11        if two lie down together, they will keep warm  
             -- but how can one be warm alone?  
12        although one can be overpowered by another, two  
             can withstand him -- and a threefold cord  
             is not quickly broken  
Prov. 18:24        a friend who sticks closer than a brother  
1 Sam. 18:3        Jonathan and David made a covenant, because he  
             loved him as his own soul  
1 Sam. 20:30        Saul was angry at Jonathan  
31        "Bring David to me"  
32        "Why should he be killed?" -- "What has he done?"  
33        Saul threw a spear at Jonathan  
34        Jonathan was grieved for David, because his  
father had treated him shamefully
