- Comment – Those 3 reasons were:
 1. To be Blessed Now
 2. To be Blessed at the Resurrection
 3. To Glorify and to Honor the Father and Son
- Comment – Here is how I subsequently covered those 3 reasons on Wednesday nights
 1. “To be Blessed Now” = 2 studies
 2. “To be Blessed at the Resurrection” = 3 studies
 3. “Obey to Glorify and Honor the Father and Son” = 3 studies

- Part 3 – Glorify and Honor the Father & Son Through Words and Actions

1. Glorify the Father and Son with Private Actions

Psalm 51:1-19	David’s repentance
Acts 2:38	repentance on Day of Pentecost
Matt. 6:1	private actions before your Father
2	not seeking glory from people
3-4	your Father (who sees in secret) will reward you openly

2. Glorify the Father and Son with Public Actions

Matt. 5:14-16	let your light shine before people – that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven
James 5:16	confess your trespasses to each other
1 Peter 2:11-12	that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may (by your good works which they observe) glorify God in the day of visitation
1 Peter 4:16	if anyone suffers as a Christian – let him glorify God in this manner

3. Glorify the Father and Son with Words

- Glorify the Father

1 Tim. 1:17 to the King eternal (immortal, invisible, to God) – be honor and glory forever and ever

- Glorify the Son

1 Tim. 2:5-6 there is one God and one mediator between God and men – Jesus Christ, who gave Himself a ransom for all (to be testified in due time)

Heb. 2:9 we see Jesus (who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death) – crowned with glory and honor – that He by the grace of God might taste death for everyone

Rev. 3:21 we will sit on the Son's throne – just as He sat of the Father's throne

John 9:24-29 they said – “give God the glory!” – they did not accept Christ

John 13:31-32 now, the Son of Man is glorified and God is glorified

- Do you praise God with your words?

Psalm 22:1-21 private prayer

1-2 My God, My God – why have You forsaken me? – why are You so far from helping me? – why are You so far from the words of My groaning? – O My God – I cry in the daytime, but You do not hear – I cry in the night season and am not silent

6-8 I am a worm and no man – a reproach of men – despised and ridiculed

14-19 I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint – my heart is like wax (it melts within me) – more examples of mistreatment

20-21 asking God for deliverance

Psalm 22:22 public words – I will declare your name to my brethren

25 public words – my praise shall be of You in the great assembly

Psalm 50:14-15 offer to God thanksgiving and pay your vows to the Most High – call upon Me in the day of trouble – I will deliver you & you shall glorify Me

Psalm 113:1-3 praise the Lord – from the rising of the sun to the setting of the sun

Psalm 145:1-2 every day, I will bless you – I will praise Your name forever

Psalm 146:1-2 praise the Lord – while I live, I will praise the Lord

Psalm 147:1 praise the Lord – it is good to sing praises to our God

Psalm 148:1-4 praise the Lord – from the heavens

7 praise the Lord – from the earth

Psalm 149:1 praise the Lord – with singing

Psalm 150:1-6 let everything that has breath – praise the Lord

Rom. 15:5-6 may the God of patience & comfort grant you to be like-minded toward one another (according to Christ Jesus) – that you may with one mind & one mouth glorify the God & Father of our Lord Jesus Christ
