- Comment – Last Wednesday, I began a two-part series
- Last week = “The First Coming of the Messiah”
- This week = “The Second Coming of the Messiah”

- When people hear messages about the second coming of the Messiah, they often want to hear about prophecy from the book of Revelation – that makes sense
- Before I read from Revelation – I will read about the Messiah from Mark’s Gospel
- If you haven’t listened to me speak before, then you are probably not aware that I prefer to talk about Christian-living principles more than prophecy predictions
- In fact, I intend to read Revelation 22:18-19 near the conclusion – If you decide to stop listening to this presentation, I hope that you will read Revelation 22:18-19 – Please be careful to avoid accepting human prophecy predictions as messages from God

Mark 13:1	in the temple – a disciple said to Him: “Teacher, look at these beautiful stones and this wonderful building”
2	“Do you see these great buildings? Not one stone will remain standing”
3-4	as He sat on the Mount of Olives – Peter, James, John & Andrew asked Him privately: “Tell us. When will these things be? What will be the sign that these things will be fulfilled?”
5-36	Mark’s version of Christ’s words
Mark 14:1-2	2 days before the Passover and Days of Unleavened Bread
3-9	a woman – (John 12:3 – Mary)
10-11	Judas – was paid to betray Christ
12	first day of Unleavened Bread
18	“One of you (who eats with Me) will betray Me”
19	the disciples asked – “Is it me?” . . . “Is it me?” . . . “Is it me?”
27	“All of you will stumble because of Me this night”
28	“I will be raised. I will go before you to Galilee”
29	Peter – “Even if all are made to stumble, I will not be made to stumble”
30	Christ – “you will deny Me 3 times”
31	Peter – more vehemently – “if I have to die with You, I will not deny You”
32-42	Garden of Gethsemane
61	the High priest asked: “Are You the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?”
62	“I am. And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven”
63	“we don’t need any more witnesses”
64	“you have heard the blasphemy” – all condemned Him; deserving of death

Mark 15:34		“My God, My God, why have you forsaken Me?”
37		Jesus cried out with a loud voice, and breathed His last
39		centurion – “truly, this Man was the Son of God!”
Mark 16:1		when the Sabbath was past, Mary Magdalen, Mary (the mother of James) and Salome brought spikes to anoint Him
4		they saw the tomb was rolled away
5		they saw a young man, in a long white robe – they were alarmed
6		he said: “Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He is risen! He is not here. See where they laid Him.”
Acts 2:22-24		Jesus of Nazareth – God has raised
29-36		God has made this Jesus (whom you have crucified) both Lord and Christ
Rev. 1:5		loved us – washed us from our sins in His own blood
6		has made us kings and priests to His God and Father – to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever
7		behold – He will be coming with clouds – every eye will see Him – even those who killed Him – and all the tribes of the earth will mourn because of Him
8		“I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End”
	·	“who is”
	·	“who was”
	·	“and who is to come”
	·	the Almighty
Rev. 11:15-18		the 7 th angel sounded his trumpet
Rev. 12:7-9		reminder – Michael and his angels fought the dragon – dragon (who deceives the whole world) was cast to the earth
10		accuser of the brethren – before God – day and night
Rev. 19:9		blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb
Rev. 20:1-3		the devil is bound
4		some brethren – are martyred
6		first resurrection
Rev. 22:18		if anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book
19		if anyone takes away the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city and from the things that are written in this book
20		“Surely, I am coming quickly” – John wrote: “Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!”
