- Comment – Recently, I began a 7-part series – from Proverbs 6:16-19
- Comment – I have discussed this subject at various times (through the years)
 - (I gave a 7-part series at Saturday church services in 2017)
 - (At that time – I gave two 40-minutes presentations – for 7 weeks)
- Proverbs 6:16-19 = mentions 7 things that God hates
- This material helps us to clearly see = 7 things that God loves
- Title – Proverbs 6:16-19 – Part 4
 - Heart With Wicked Imaginations – Caring Heart With Righteous Purposes

- Heart With Wicked Imaginations – That Certainly Sounds Like Satan
- Serpent (more cunning) – against Adam and Eve
 - Gen. 3:1-5 serpent – more cunning
 - 1 “set-up” question
 - 4 contradicted the Lord God
 - 5 created doubt
- Satan – against Job
 - Job 1:8 the Lord asked – “Have you considered My servant Job?”
 - 9-11 Satan – suggested details for the trial – “stretch out your hand”
 - 12 the Lord approved the details – the Lord set up limitations
 - Job 2:3 the Lord asked – “Have you considered My servant Job?”
 - 4-5 Satan – suggested new details for the trial – “stretch out your hand”
 - 6 the Lord approved the details – the Lord set up limitations
- Devil – against the Son of God
 - Matt. 4:1-9 sought to convince the Son of God – to fall down & worship him
- Satan – against Peter
 - Matt. 16:23 turned and said to Peter – “get behind Me, Satan”
 - Luke 22:31 “Satan has asked for you, that he may sift you as wheat”
- Satan – against Paul
 - 2 Cor. 11:14 Satan transforms himself into an angel of light
 - 2 Cor. 12:7 a thorn in the flesh – from Satan – to “buffet me”
- Demons – against the children of God
 - James 2:19 there is one God – even the demons believe (and tremble)

- Civil leaders – were against the Son of God
 - Luke 23:1 the chief priests and scribes led Him to Pilate
 - 4 Pilate said – “I find no fault in this Man”
 - 5-7 when the crowd mentioned Galilee, Pilate sent Him to Herod
 - 8 Herod was happy to meet Christ
 - 11 Herod & men treated Him with contempt – sent Him back to Pilate
 - 12 on that day, Pilate and Herod became friends – previous enmity
 - 14 Pilate said – “I have found no fault in this Man”
 - 16 Pilate said – “I will chastise Him and release Him”
 - Religious leaders – were against the Son of God
 - Luke 11:53 to cross-examine Him – lying in wait for Him – seeking to catch Him in something He might say – they might accuse Him
 - Luke 20:20 watched Him – sent spies (who pretended to be righteous) to seize on His words – in order to deliver Him to the power and the authority of the governor
 - John 11:53 from that day on, they plotted to put Him to death
 - 54 therefore, Jesus no longer walked openly among the Jews

· Caring Heart With Righteous Purposes – Sounds Like the Father & Son

- FYI – I could use the same verses from last week’s Bible study about “Hands to Help the Guilty” to show the love that the Father and Son have for all of mankind – but tonight, I will focus on additional verses
- The Father & Son have a caring heart – Here are a 2 scriptures repeated from last week
 - Luke 19:41-44 the Son wept over Jerusalem
 - Luke 22:41-44 the Garden of Gethsemane
- The Father & Son have a caring heart – Some new verses
 - Luke 4:18-19 goals of the Son of God – especially notice 2 of them – to heal the brokenhearted; and to set at liberty those who are oppressed
 - John 10:28-29 no one can snatch you out of the hands of the Father & Son
 - John 11:35 Jesus wept – about the death of Lazarus
 - John 19:25-27 the Son cared for His mother
- Examples of the children of God – having a caring heart (with righteous purposes)
 - Acts 4:36 Barnabas – which is translated Son of Encouragement
 - Acts 9:24-25 disciples – let Paul down the wall in a large basket
 - 27 Barnabas – took Paul to the apostles in Jerusalem
 - Acts 9:39 widows – weeping & showing the garments Dorcas made
 - Rom. 14:1 receive one who is weak in the faith – not to disputes
 - Rom. 15:1 the strong ought to bear the weak
 - Phil. 2:20-22 Paul mentioned the example of Timothy
 - 1 Thes. 2:7-8 Paul was gentle among the brethren – as a nursing mother
 - 2 Tim. 1:16-18 Onesiphorus – traveled to Rome to see Paul
